i. Literacy Update: Students will demonstrate improvement in writing with a focus on reading engagement and choice. Teachers identified a lack of reading engagement, which they feel is influencing students' writing ability. Teachers implemented a variety of mini lessons. They found that students who are usually engaged, remain engaged. There has been a slight increase in engagement from disengaged students, however, most disengaged students remain reluctant to read. Comprehension appears to be the barrier for engagement. To gather more information, the Dibels assessment was done with grade 7s to record a reading comprehension baseline. Next teachers will be working on text attack strategies - how to approach unfamiliar text.
ii. Math Update: To improve student achievement in Number Sense with a focus on Reasoning. Math teachers have started a book study on Daily Reasoning Routines. Grade 7s and 8s will look at open ended questions that generate discussion about what solutions can look like and why. Grade 9s are using the stock market to connect understanding of the impact of negative and positive numbers to stock values.
