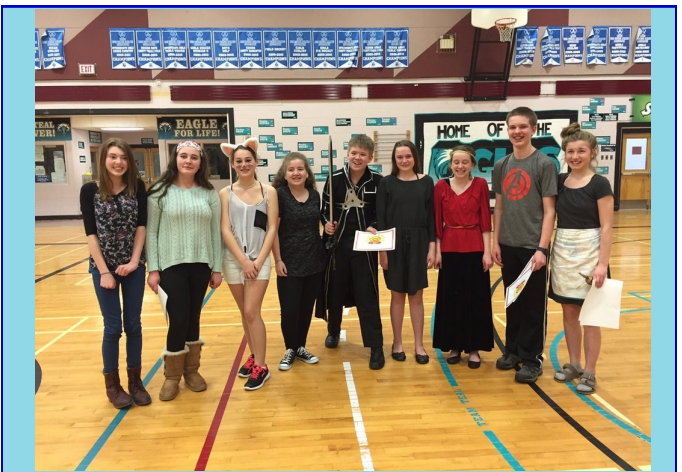

Why 52? 52 cards in a deck.

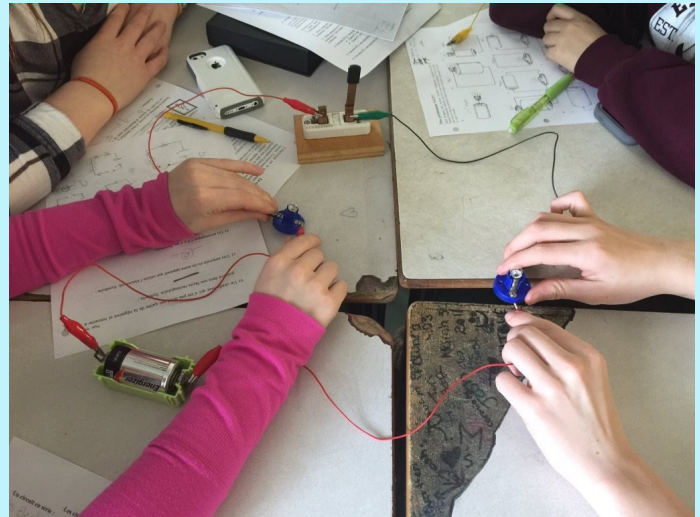
52 names go in for a draw - first name drawn gets to flip over a card.
